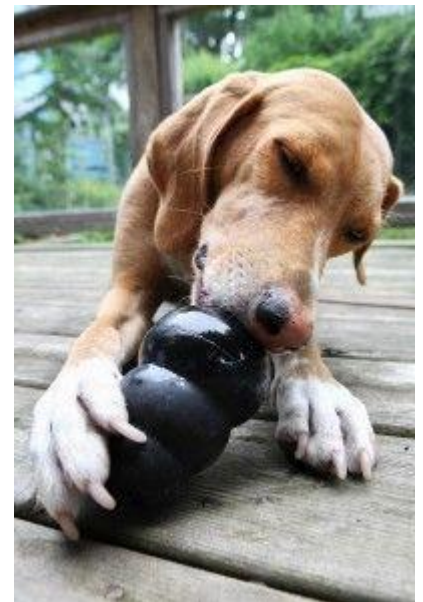

Pro Tip: For a longer lasting Kong, put in the freezer for 4 hours after stuffing.
