About the SPCA of Texas:

The SPCA of Texas is the leading animal welfare organization in North Texas. Founded in 1938, the non-profit operates two shelters, an equine/livestock center, two spay/neuter clinics, two mobile spay/neuter and wellness vehicles, one mobile adoptions vehicle and an animal rescue center, all located in Dallas, Collin and Ellis Counties, and maintains a team of animal cruelty investigators who respond to thousands of calls in North Texas counties. The organization does not euthanize animals for time or space. Moreover, the SPCA of Texas serves as an active resource center for an array of services that bring people and animals together to enrich each other's lives. The SPCA of Texas is not affiliated with any other entity and does not receive general operating funds from the City of Dallas, State of Texas, federal government or any other national humane organization. The SPCA of Texas is dedicated to providing every animal exceptional care and a loving home.

The SPCA of Texas rescues, heals and finds homes for the most vulnerable pets in our community, and provides essential resources for the people who love them. Most people know us for our adoptable pets and our fantastic corps of volunteers, however, we offer so many other lifesaving programs. To name just a few, our Animal Cruelty Investigations unit helps remove animals from abuse and cruelty in several different counties in North Texas. Also, Let's Fix This! Free Fix provides free spay/neuter surgeries for dogs of people who live in 23 Southern Dallas zip codes. Importantly, our Kivo Mobile Clinic provides low-cost vaccinations, microchips, flea/tick/heartworm prevention, and other preventative care for pets in Underserved areas across the Metroplex.
